Vocabulary words:

Students need to know the definitions of the following words and be able to put the following words into sentences of their own.

Fugitive: A person running away from imprisonment or intolerable conditions.

Heritage: Something that belongs to someone from birth

Network: A system of related buildings, stations, etc.

Shelter: A safe place where someone is protected.

Accompanied: Went somewhere with someone.

Aid: Help or support given to someone.

Code: A way to use words, letters, or numbers to send secret messages.

Goal: Something you want to achieve in the future.

Plot: Is the sequence of related events in a story.

Conflict: A problem to be solved in a piece of literature, conflict can be with a person and their Inner feelings, nature e.g. The weather or one person with another person.
