to the Library




It has been a very busy period for the library team.

you are going to enjoy the new library space.



Martin Luther King, Jr. became the youngest man to have received the Nobel Peace Prize; he was also awarded five honorary degrees.


He's most famous and impactful speech was in Washington, D.C.



# World Read Aloud Day (WRAD):

Students & teachers were invited to celebrate and enjoy the read aloud story sessions held at the D7 Library to commemorate WRAD 2020.





Students were awarded certificates for their awesome participation. Well Done!



The students were eager to read the stories for themselves that they were back in the library to borrow the different titles that were read aloud. Success!





Follow Amy and Dan as they travel the world to hunt for clues that unlock the family's power. We meet Amy and Dan Cahill who are orphan.
