#### Requirements:

1. Travel details for departure & return
  - a. Airline, layovers, cost, and total travel time.
2. Destination(s)
  - a. Three different cities/locations in your country
3. Hotel
  - a. Two hotel options per city
    - i. The hotel's rating (3 – 5 stars)
    - ii. 3 amenities for each hotel
    - iii. The cost of the hotel
4. Activities
  - a. 2 Unique activities for each location
    - i. Cost
    - ii. Explain why you would want to do it
5. Transportation
  - a. Cost of renting a car
  - b. Cost of fuel
