KFH announces Al-Rabeh winners

Dasman Bilingual School students learn about thinking, self-learning

DBS conducts workshop by Dr Cash

KUWAIT CITY, Nov 21: In a bid to raise educational standards, Dasman Bilingual School (DBS) has invited Educational Consultant and Writer Dr Richard M. Cash to head a three day workshop on Advancing Differentiation: Thinking and self-learning.

With around sixty educators participating, the workshop kicked off Tuesday Dr Cash addressing self-regulation and how kids manage themselves in the learning process, while the second day focused on differentiation and how to differentiate up, so that all students will have a chance to grow and achieve at higher levels. And on the third day Dr Cash is to talk about the different types of strategies and technique that could be used to help advanced level learners.

In a press conference prior to the workshop, Superintendent at Dasman Bilingual School Mrs Samar Dizmen stated that Dasman Bilingual School is the only inclusive school in the region, making the subject of differentiation a priority for the school. Which is why all participants were excited to join the workshop, as Dr Cash in one of the few educators that has put in tremendous effort on the subject of self-regulation.

Excellent

"This is an excellent step forward," added Mrs Samar as she explained how the workshop will help educators help their students regulate their own behaviours, hoping that this would relieve them from getting blamed for alleged shortcomings, an issue they frequently face.

Furthermore, Dasman Bilingual School has recently introduced a new program for gifted students, making the workshop even more beneficial as Dr Cash has written a book on the subject and will discuss it during the workshop alongside his other two publications, Advancing Differentiation and Self-Regulation in the Classroom.

Explaining what differentiation means in the educational field, Dr Richard M. Cash said that the basic tenant behind differentiation is that the teacher has to know enough about every student, to then be able to adjust and modify curricular and instructional practices the best of the student's needs, moving them towards success.

He then mentioned that the philosophy of differentiation has been out there for many years but is now becoming much more important due to the significant changes in our time. As students nowadays are going to face more obstacles upon joining the workforce, it's not just about their skillset anymore more than it is about their way of thought when coming about certain matters.

Differentiation is a commonplace term in schools today, but it's anything but a commonplace idea. Differentiating instruction is about so much more than simply tailoring materials and activities to different students, it's about deeply engaging every learner.

Challenging students to move beyond the curriculum, think critically, and generate new ideas. Helping students managing their emotions and behaviors, direct their own learning, connect concepts across content areas, and ultimately, make sense of their world.


Excellence
